



## ACCESSING SOM SHARES USING NETWORK CONNECT

1. Launch your internet browser, [click here to see a list of supported browsers](#), and type **vpn.ucsf.edu**, then **Sign In** using your VPN account.



Please sign in to begin your secure session.

For your protection vpn@ucsf automatically closes the VPN session after one hour of inactivity.

2. Once login, click **Start** on **Network Connect** to install network connect virtual adapter:

Also, check to make sure pop-up blocker is temporarily turned off before installing the Network Connect adapter for the first time.



- Once Network Connect Adapter has been installed successfully, you will see it listed in your Programs:

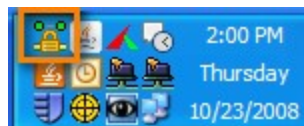


You can create a shortcut to Network Connect on your desktop, so the next you want to connect, just double-click on it.

- Launch Network Connect and make sure the Sign-in Page is **vpn.ucsf.edu**, then sign using your VPN account:



Once you have established a secure connection you will see a yellow pad lock icon minimize itself at the bottom of your system tray:
